WHAT IS THE EMERGENCY SHELTER & THE SUPERVISED TRANSITIONAL LIVING PROGRAM (STLP)?

 The Emergency Youth Shelter is open 24/7/365 to youth aged 10-19. The shelter is in a small ranch house with a home-like atmosphere. The shelter will provide you with short-term housing and basic needs, including food, clothing, hygiene items, etc. You will also be able to receive individual, group, and family counseling sessions and take part in recreational and psychoeducational groups.

 The Supervised Transitional Living Program (STLP) is a group home setting for youth aged 16-21 that provides temporary housing with the opportunity to obtain long-term housing. STLP will provide you with services and life skills to guide you into adulthood and help you gain independence. STLP focuses on education, vocational training, employment, and life skills like budgeting, nutrition, and housekeeping. You can also participate in individual, group, and family counseling to meet your goals.

REMEMBER:

Homelessness does not define you.

Often, homelessness occurs for reasons beyond your control. At Ocean's Harbor House, you will have the potential to achieve your goals and become the person you want to be.
